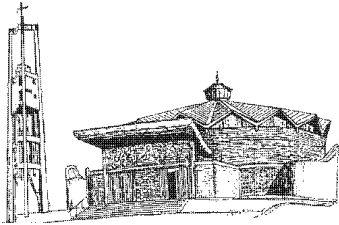

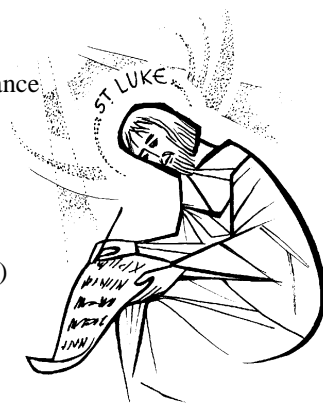

Parish AGM thanksgiving and celebration takes place on Friday 12th November at 7pm to end in Church by 8pm at the latest. The PPC have come up with a different format to past years, in the spirit of promoting what Parishioners identified as the main hope and expectation from their priests: - "the building up and strengthening of our Parish Community." You shall love your neighbour as yourself (Mt 22:39)

Who can give us such a big heart? Who can stir up in us such kindness that we feel even those who are most unlike us, those most distant from us, as neighbours, as close, that we overcome our self-love and see our self in others?
