PARISH AGM - FRIDAY, 12 NOVEMBER: Parish AGM thanksgiving and celebration takes place on Friday 12th November at 7pm to end in Church by 8pm at the latest. All Parishioners are welcome those who belong to groups and those who don't. Food and drink in the Parish Centre and socialising, from 8pm onwards. The PPC have come up with a different format to past years, in the spirit of promoting what Parishioners identified as the main hope and expectation from their priests: - "the building up and strengthening of our Parish Community." In Church it will not be a Mass but a liturgy of the Word of thanksgiving and celebration for our parish; symbols of each group will be brought to the front. All members of the group will participate if possible in a simple way A few groups will speak briefly of how they serve the community and will pray on behalf of that group from their perspective. We will present the Parish accounts in Church, and parishioners will receive a copy of these accounts beforehand enabling questions. We will welcome any comments or questions about any aspect of Parish life. These will be in writing so we can choose (if too many) the most important ones. All questions will be answered but not necessarily that night. We hope many come and join in the thanksgiving and celebration service, which will be graced by the presence of Archbishop Kelly. Archbishop Patrick who is visiting our St. Mary's Technology College that very day.

WORD OF LIFE Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. (Mt 5:8). *Jesus begins his preaching with the Sermon on the Mount. On a hill near Lake Tiberius, not far from Capernaum, Jesus sat down, as was customary for teachers, and described to the crowds what it means for a human being to be blessed. The word for beatitude, 'blessed', had been heard throughout the Old Testament. It spoke of the exaltation of the one who, in the widest variety of ways, fulfilled the Word of the Lord.*
