**Bishop Ambrose's Legacy** From the many cards we have received, from the tributes both on our website and that of the Hexham and Newcastle Diocese and from our experience of Fr. Ambrose, we were blessed in Leyland to have had such a man among us as our Pastor and friend. *Anyone who wishes may leave money in a memorial fund making cheques payable to St. Mary's Leyland and with the name of Fr. Ambrose on the back, or place money in one of the Parish Envelopes, adding the name Fr. Ambrose.* The money will be used as explained below:

Fr. Ambrose had a very developed love for anyone on the edge of society, anyone who felt lost or abandoned, both the materially poor and the spiritually poor. He was a very keen supporter of the Newman Fund and saw it as an outlet better to support such people. He has been helping two specific people in far away countries as well, and his specific wish is that we continue to help these needy people; and that we want to do. His compassion and kindness were paramount and seemed almost "to go over the top"; the results were that he really did change people's lives for good. As a legacy to Fr. Ambrose we will incorporate his name with the Newman fund in some way, and the Legacy money will be used according to the criteria of the Newman Fund and for the specific people mentioned above. Its motto is: LOCAL PEOPLE HELPING THE LOCAL COMMUNITY FOR THE LOCAL COMMUNITY. This implies that God's Love will grow among us and help us to respond to each other and grow in our responsibilities for the good of all as situations arise according to the guide lines that Fr. Ambrose had seen and are already laid out.
