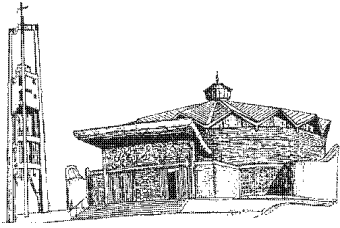

Those who love me will be loved by my Father, and I will love them and reveal myself to them. (Jn 14:21)
