<u>Some facts and figures:</u> Our parish was founded in 1845. The foundation stone of the new church was laid by Archbishop Heenan on 15th September 1962 and the church was consecrated by Archbishop Beck on 4th April 1964. In today's money the cost of the church would be £8 million.

The "ceremonial mallet" that was used to lay the foundation stone of the extension of the old church in 1919, and that of the new church in 1962, has been restored and is now displayed in a cabinet at the back of church.
