<u>Pentecost Prayer:</u> A special prayer to the Holy Spirit has been composed, and parishioners have been asked to translate it into their own languages. On Pentecost Sunday we will pray the prayer together in the many languages spoken in our parish, as a sign of our cultural diversity, and our unity in one faith in the Lord.

A statement from Archbishop John Sherrington: "We hold in our thoughts and prayers all those involved in the incident in Liverpool city centre last Monday.

At the Mass of Installation at the cathedral, we prayed for the injured, their families, friends, and the whole community. We give thanks for the emergency services who attended the scene so quickly and remember in our prayers all of those who are working in the hospitals and treating the patients. I know that the people of Liverpool will walk together to support those who are suffering, and the city has the capacity to rebuild itself again after tragedy. This is the spirit of Liverpool that I am proud to have joined. We pray for God's blessing, God's peace, and God's presence today."

<u>First Communion:</u> The children have had their final preparation. Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion on Saturday, 7th June.

Good Shepherd Mass: "Nugent" is the official Archdiocesan charity that offers care and outreach to those in need. The origins of Nugent date back to Victorian Liverpool and the pioneering work of Father James Nugent (1822-1905) in relation to child welfare, relief from poverty and social reform. Through his ministry, Father Nugent witnessed first-hand the suffering caused by poverty and appalling conditions and took action to remedy the situation. By the time of his death, Father Nugent had given homes and valuable skills to thousands of children and laid the foundations for the work undertaken by Nugent today. During the year, our Catholic schools fundraise to support Nugent, and this is celebrated at the Good Shepherd Masses in June each year. One Mass takes place in the Metropolitan Cathedral and one here in St Mary's. We look forward to welcoming schools from the northern part of the Archdiocese on the 12th of June.
