<u>Archbishop Sherrington's statement on the assisted suicide bill:</u> Archbishop Sherrington released a statement this week responding to ministers voting in favour of the bill.

The Archbishop writes: "The Bishops of England and Wales are shocked and disappointed, and its principles give us great cause for concern. Catholic institutions could become under threat should they be required to co-operate with assisted suicide. We believe that improving the quality and availability of palliative care offers the best pathway to reducing the suffering at the end of life."

As a Catholic community, we are urged to continue to pray for the MPs that they will provide and safeguard life from beginning to end.
