New altar server training: This will take place from 7.00pm - 7.30pm on the following Wednesdays -9^{th} , 16^{th} July; 3^{rd} , 10^{th} , 17^{th} September.

Archbishop's Pallium: Last Sunday, the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, Pope Leo gave all recently appointed Archbishops their pallium, which is a band of lambswool worn on the shoulders over the chasuble. It symbolises the communion between the Bishop of Rome and the Metropolitan Archbishops whom he has appointed to oversee the Church. Our Archbishop was one of 54 to receive the pallium in St Peter's Basilica.

<u>Mass of Anointing:</u> This year's Mass of the Anointing of the Sick will take place at 11.00am on Saturday, 2nd August. Eucharistic Ministers will be given invitation letters to give to the housebound of the parish.

Catholic Association for Racial Justice: At a recent conference, which was attended by some of our parishioners, parishes were invited to look at how the different cultures and ethnic backgrounds of parishioners are recognised and valued. In our parish we have a good cross section of people involved in the different ministries of Word, Altar, music, welcome, etc. But one area that has not been addressed is images of saints. Whilst the architecture of our church does not lend itself to having lots of statues, the architect's vision was to have mosaics of saints in the side chapels of St Joseph and St Anne. As that would be prohibitively expensive, we will place three framed images of saints from across the world in each side chapel to help us in our prayer and devotion.
