All parishioners are invited to attend this archdiocesan celebration of our Archbishop Emeritus and his ministry among us.

Restoration of the Catholic Hierarchy: 29<sup>th</sup> September 2025 marks the 175th anniversary of the restoration of the Catholic Hierarchy of England and Wales in 1850 by Pope Blessed Pius IX following the Reformation. It therefore also marks the 175th birthday of the (Arch)diocese of Liverpool.
