
Members of our Family of Parishes (Tarleton, Longton, Leyland, & Penwortham) have been meeting over the last year. The Working Group consists of 2 lay representatives from each of the 4 parishes plus the 4 priests & 2 deacons.

We are sharing the one-page summary of our last meeting, and a member of the working group will speak at Mass the w/e 13th/14th September. Do you see yourself in this summary? Is there anything you would like to add?

We invite everyone to enter into this conversation and offer us any feedback, either by email to <u>j.sargent@rcaol.org.uk</u> or by handing back the sheet at church.

The Working Group will be meeting over the next 8-12 months with Fr Matthew Nunes as our facilitator. We will be discerning how we can work more closely together to prepare for the future. Across the whole Archdiocese, active membership of parishes has continued to fall. Our Family currently consists of 4 parishes, with 5 churches, 6 primary schools, 2 high schools, 5 parish halls/centres, 8 Sunday Masses (3 Saturday evening vigils & 5 Sunday morning), 4 priests, & 2 deacons. In 5 years' time, we might be lucky to have 2 priests. How do we prepare for the future so that our communities can be vibrant and outward looking in our calling to live and proclaim the Gospel of Jesus in this area of South Ribble?

Please could we invite you over the next month to continue this conversation with each other – over a cuppa, or in one of your parish group meetings. If you have a parish council or an open parish meeting coming up, please do take that opportunity to continue the conversation.



Journey in Faith: Do you know someone who would be interested in becoming a Catholic?

As a Family of Parishes, we are delighted to confirm that we will again be offering **a Journey** in Faith (RCIA) course for anyone who may be interested in joining our Catholic family of faith.

Our first course leading up to Easter 2025, proved very helpful to the 15 adults who were baptised or received into the Church and then confirmed and made their first Communion.

This year's course, which begins on 12th November 2026, and which will be run at St Mary's Community Centre Leyland, is a wonderful opportunity for those who want to explore the Catholic faith to do so in an informal and welcoming environment.

A team of parishioners across our Family of Parishes will host the sessions and together with our clergy we will be following the excellent resources provided by the Sycamore course.

The sessions will run weekly (with breaks over holiday periods) until Easter 2026 and include topics such as The Search for Happiness, Who is Jesus? and the Power of Prayer.


Season of Creation
