Can you remember your Latin?? At Fr Joe's Ruby Jubilee Mass, it is planned that we will sing the "Our Father" in Latin. From September we will be practising at both weekend Masses, and the congregation will be given a copy of the text and music.

Season of Creation. Week 3 reflection: Why must we care for creation? Pope Saint John Paul II said that "we are cooperative co-creators, and our participation lies at the basis of a healing world, a world aimed towards the fullness of God". The behaviour of those who constantly consume and destroy is unsustainable, while others are not yet able to live in a way worthy of their human dignity. Pope Benedict XVI said that "technologically advanced societies must be prepared to encourage more sober lifestyles, while reducing their energy consumption and improving its efficiency".

<u>Family of Parishes Working Group:</u> The Liverpool Archdiocesan Synod and the resulting Pastoral Plan established local Families of Parishes and called for local reflection and discernment in each Family to grow in greater collaboration as we prepare for the future together.

Members of our Family of Parishes (Tarleton, Longton, Leyland, & Penwortham) have been meeting over the last year. The Working Group consists of 2 lay representatives from each of the 4 parishes plus the 4 priests & 2 deacons.

We are sharing the one-page summary of our last meeting and some guiding questions, and a member of the working group will speak at Mass this weekend.

**EMPOWERING:** Creating activities that develop young peoples' skills and confidence and providing a platform to express themselves.

**CELEBRATING:** Creating opportunities to affirm and thank young people, recognising their valuable contributions to social change.
