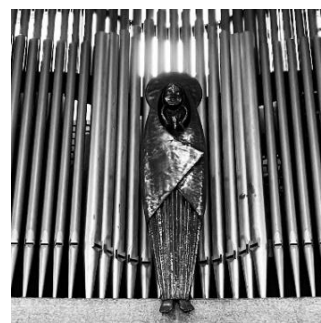

Holy water: As Catholics, we have the custom of blessing ourselves with holy water as we enter and leave church. We do this to remind ourselves of our baptism. Parishioners are invited to bless themselves from the baptismal font at the entrance to the church.

20+C+M+B+26: The Epiphany blessing originated in medieval central Europe as a house blessing to commemorate the visit of the three Magi (Wise Men) to the newly born Jesus.

- The numbers represent the year **2026**.
- The “+” signs represent the cross of Christ.
- The letter **C**, **M**, and **B** are the initials of the traditional names of the three Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar.
- **CMB** also forms an acronym for the Latin phrase ***Christus mansionem benedicat*** which translates to “**May Christ bless this house**”.

Don't forget to mark the doorpost of your houses with chalk if you haven't already done so!

Crib Offerings: A box, for your offerings, has been placed near the crib in the narthex throughout the Season of Christmas. This year's crib offerings from parishes across the Archdiocese of Liverpool will be securely passed on to the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem; a diocese of the Catholic Church whose territory includes Cyprus, Jordan, Israel, and Palestine. This ensures your generosity directly supports Christians living in these areas.
