Deanery statistics: In the Lancashire Deanery, which stretches from Tarleton to Chorley, there are currently 17 parishes and 12 diocesan priests in parish ministry. Within five years' time there will only be 6 priests in our deanery, as the others will have reached 75, the usual age for retirement from active ministry. There were no ordinations to the priesthood in the Archdiocese in 2025 and there will only be one this year.

Journey in faith: We are blessed that there is a good number of baptised Christians who are preparing to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church, and some unbaptised people who are seeking the Sacraments of Initiation. They will be officially presented to the parish at the **10.00am Mass on Sunday, 15th February** so that we can support them with our prayers. On Sunday, 22nd February (1st Sunday of Lent) they will be presented to the Archbishop in the Cathedral at the Rite of Election and will become Catholics at the Easter Vigil in the parish on 4th April.

St Anne's Primary School: Last Thursday a Mass was celebrated in school to mark the launch of the school's new Mission Statement – **"Kind hearts. Bright minds. One family"**.

Vernacular language at Mass: It was in December 1964 when Pope Paul VI promulgated the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy after it was approved by 2,147 of the 2,151 bishops present at the Second Vatican Council. A new rite of Mass was introduced on the 1st Sunday of Advent 1969, and it is the norm that it is celebrated in the vernacular, the local language of the place. However, Article 54 of the Constitution states that *"steps should be taken so that the faithful may also be able to say or sing together in Latin those parts of the Mass that pertain to them."* That is why we sing the Our Father (**Pater Noster**) in Latin once a month, and occasionally the Lamb of God (**Agnus Dei**).

Sacristy improvements: Thanks to the generosity of The Wrennalls Group, the sacristy and office corridor have been carpeted.

Legacy: As a parish, we are blessed to have just received an anonymous legacy of £10,000.
