**WORD OF LIFE** *Martha, Martha, you are worried and distracted by many things; there is need of only one thing. (Lk: 10:41-42)*

*Was Jesus not happy with the enterprise and generous service of Martha? Did he not appreciate her real and practical welcome and would he not have been happy to eat the food that was being prepared?*

*What he criticizes is the state of bother and worry that goes into the work. Martha is agitated, 'distracted by her many tasks'; she has lost her calm. It is no longer she who controls her work that has taken control and tyrannizes her. She is no longer free, but she has become a slave to what she does.*
