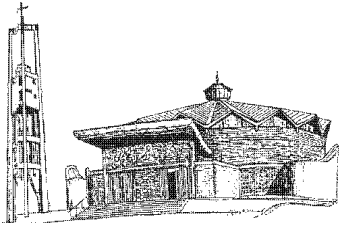

As usual there are challenges and now we have to find the right way to go ahead for our Ampleforth Trustees to accept our proposals. We still are paying off the 74K that was the cost for repairing the concrete and painting the Church last year which affects this new project. Please continue to pray for the success of this first stage so that we can have the new boiler installed before next winter. Money raising will continue and our funds are still increasing bit by bit. The initiative of Monica Knight is a welcome one. We will publish all final details as soon as we can, and we thank those who are working hard and worrying about this project on our behalf.
