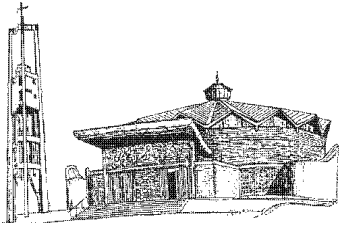

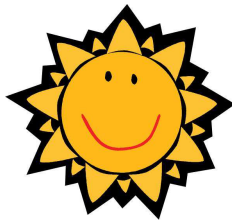
**NEXT SUNDAY: Birthday of John the Baptist**
