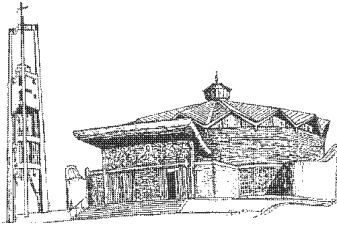

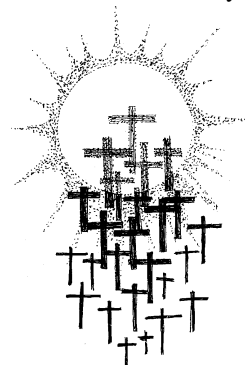

But if you endure when you do right and suffer for it, you have God's approval (1 Pt 2:20)

We can say this: even on all these occasions we have to give witness to the love that Jesus brought to earth for everyone and so, also, for those who treat us badly.

Pope Francis has blown a fresh new Spirit over the Church in the last three months since his election.

(Not all would agree with this view!)

How? In what he has done, in what he says, and through his personality and non European background and experience. Each day he preaches "off the cuff" and so his inspired words cannot be taken as "official". They are simple and easily understood.
