



## The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, or the Solemnity of



Saints Peter and Paul, is a liturgical feast in honour of the martyrdom in Rome of the apostles Saint Peter and Saint Paul, which is observed on 29 June. The celebration is of ancient origin, the date selected being either the anniversary of their death or of the translation of their relics. It is a holy day of obligation. This is the day of the liturgical year on which those newly created metropolitan archbishops receive the primary symbol

of their office, the pallium, from the pope. The Pallium is made of wool; the Bishop is the Good Shepherd of the flock.

**Pupils at our Schools** will keep the feast day liturgically at Church either coming to the evening vigil mass or the evening mass of the day, or the 9.15am mass. Those who attend the 9.15am mass from our Catholic technology college will receive a slip of paper from Miss Metcalfe who will be in Church so they can be registered on accurately. Primary school Pupils who attend the 9.15am mass will be registered when the family member in charge of them returns them to school after mass.

**Pope Benedict's visit** This feast day is always a special one for the Papacy. The Orthodox Patriarch of Constantinople sends a delegation each year to Rome (The Pope sends a Delegation to Istanbul for the feast of St. Andrew each year). It is a very good day to pray for the Pope, our Bishops, and especially this year when he comes to visit our country. There is an excellent booklet available in the Narthex, "Heart speaks unto Heart" about the Papal visit that helps any reader to feel proud of being Catholic when you see what the Church humbly offers our world and our nation.

**Welcome** to Fr. Luis Fernando, Carvajal Noreña who will be with us for three months learning English. He is a diocesan priest from Colombia, South America, doing biblical studies in Rome.
