## **PARISH WAY OF LIFE INITIATIVE.**

*Our focus and theme for our 'Way of Life' initiative for the next few weeks is 'Mercy'. Pope Francis, in proclaiming this year a year of Mercy states - 'The Church must be a place of Mercy freely given'. So what does the word Mercy mean? Remember also to be merciful to yourself & others. The following may help:*

- "When we are merciful we are kind or forgiving toward someone vulnerable, perhaps someone over whom we hold power. Mercy lets us set aside questions of equity, justice, vengeance, or even blame; it asks not what a person deserves, but what they need.
- Understanding the brokenness of other people and the pressures they experience makes it easier to be merciful. Mercy is intimately tied to compassion and empathy.
- Without mercy, the world would be a harsh, exacting place. When we recognise the grace we have received----- all of the times that we have, mercifully, not gotten what we deserve---we often find in ourselves a desire to give others the same gift."

**WORD OF LIFE** *Take courage: I have conquered the world! John 16:33* It is really true. Even while joy is spread all along the path we follow, there is no lack of 'persecution'. We experience uncertainty about the future, job insecurity, poverty and sickness, suffering as a result of natural disasters and wars, violence at home and among nations. There are in addition the persecutions that come as a result of being Christians: the daily struggle to be faithful to the Gospel.
