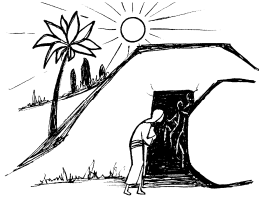

Papal Visit for our Pastoral Area: 18th & 19th September

Fr. Jonathan considers this a chance to be involved in a great moment for God and his kingdom here in England especially in the light of supporting the Pope in what may be a tricky time. Bear in mind that in USA his visit was surprisingly a great success, and similarly in Australia at the time of the International Youth Festival last year. In both USA and Australia there was opposition to the Pope coming.

1. We have been invited to the Papal Prayer Vigil in London on Saturday 18th September at 5pm in Hyde Park. The event will be over by 9pm. The cost, apart from travel, will be £10 (giving you a Zone 1 London underground pass and a pilgrim pack). At the moment an idea is to take a coach from Leyland leaving in the morning. Details later. Each group has to enter Hyde Park together with the Group Leader
2. We have been invited to the Papal Mass in Cofton Park, Birmingham Sunday 19th September (9.30am) for the beatification of Cardinal Newman. This will cost £25 and will be by coach organised by the national organisers. The details of where and when the coach picks people up is organised nationally (but it must be an early start: Cofton Park will be open from 3am!!) Cost includes the travel and the pilgrim pack.
