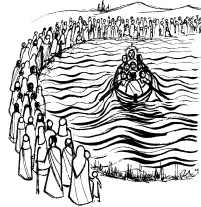

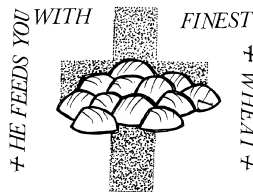
HOLY COMMUNION FOR THE SICK

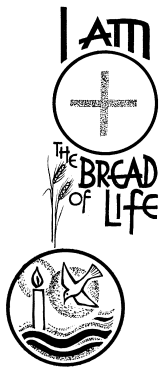

WORD OF LIFE

For those who have, more will be given, and they will have an abundance; but for those who have nothing, even what they have will be taken away. (Mt 13:12)

This Word of Life warns us against making a terrible mistake: that of accepting the Gospel, perhaps even making it the object of study, admiration and discussion, but not putting it into practice. Instead, Jesus expects us to accept the Word and to incarnate it within us. It is to become the driving force that guides all our activities, so that, through the witness of our life, it may be the light, salt and yeast that gradually transform society.
