



Day for Life - the day in the Church's year dedicated to celebrating the dignity of life from conception to natural death - will this year focus on what it means to live a full and happy life. It takes as its starting point the words of Pope Benedict during his recent visit to Britain, when he said: 'Happiness is something we all want, but one of the great tragedies in this world is that so many people never find it, because they look for it in the wrong places. The key to it is very simple - true happiness is to be found in God. We need to have the courage to place our deepest hopes in God alone, not in money, in a career, in worldly success, or in our relationships with others, but in God. Only he can satisfy the deepest needs in our hearts.' There will be a second collection today to support Day for Life. Proceeds of the collection will go to The Anscombe Bioethics Centre (formerly the Linacre Centre for Healthcare Ethics) and other life-related activities supported by the Church.

Pilgrimage to the Holy Land, "In the footsteps of Jesus"

15th March - 22nd March 2012. Fr. Jonathan is, God willing, going on this ecumenical pilgrimage organised by the Focolare Movement to the Holy Land - the second time in his life, because of your generosity for the 40th jubilee of priesthood. Pilgrims stay in very comfortable hotels in the Palestinian area of the Holy Land. They see not only the stones and remains where Jesus passed and the Church had its heritage, but meet the living stones of those Christians, Moslems and Jews who want to build unity there. It was a "wow" experience last time. Anyone interested contact Fr. Jonathan for details some of which are given below.

Fr. Jonathan has booked and the flight from Manchester 10am with Jet 2 returning from Tel Aviv on 22nd March for 10pm is £376.15 (including meals with one hand luggage but not choosing special seats on the plane). Hotels are: Mary's Well Hotel, Nazareth 3 nights, Casanova Guest House Bethlehem 4 nights and cost for a double room is £530 or Single supplement of £150. Total cost for the week including the coaches and guides and accommodation and flights is c. £907 for a double room or £1057 for a single room.

WORD OF LIFE

Stay awake and pray that you may not come into the time of trial; the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak. (Mt 26:41)

Prayer is necessary because at such moments we are particularly open to two temptations. One is to think we can go it alone. The other is the opposite, the fear of not being able to cope, as if the trial were greater than our strength. Jesus instead assures us that our heavenly Father will not leave us without the strength of the Holy Spirit if we are watchful and if we ask him for this strength with faith.
