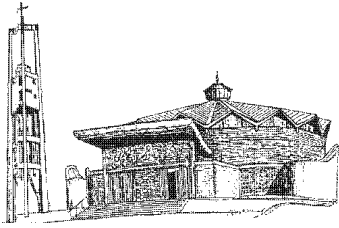

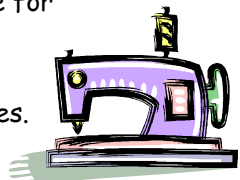

Right to Life Walk around Clitheroe.

Monday 27th August 1.30pm. Meeting & Finishing Point - St Michael & St John's RC Church, Lowergate, Clitheroe BB7 1AQ. This walk is also called "The Phyllis Bowman Memorial Walk" after the death of Phyllis Bowman 7th May 2012.. Right to life is doing all it can to resist the lobby that will allow legalisation of assisted suicide, often called the pro-assisted death lobby, which is highly funded. Right to Life has very little funding and does all it can to promote sane pro-life thinking and arguments in Parliament, but is very short of money.  This Word of Life is a source of great joy and encouragement to all Christians. With it Jesus calls us to live truly according to our faith in him because our eternal destiny depends on the attitude we adopt towards him during our earthly life. If we acknowledge him before others, he says, we will give him reason to acknowledge us before his Father. If, on the other hand, we deny him before others, he too will deny us before his Father.
