A REFLECTION. Jesus tells us in the gospel not to let our hearts be troubled. He will be with us through the coming of the Holy Spirit.

WORD OF LIFE "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." (Jn 20:21).

Chiara Lubich wrote a commentary on this Word of Life in May 2005: "Nowadays, words are not enough... The proclamation of the Gospel will be effective if it is based on testimonies such as those given by the first Christians who said, "We declare to you what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes." It will be effective if what was said of them can be said of us: "See how they love one another, and each one is ready to die for the others". It will be effective if our love is practical and we give food, clothing and shelter to those who need them; if we offer friendship to those who are alone and desperate, and support people in trying times. By living in this way, others will experience the wonder of knowing Jesus and, by becoming other Christs, will contribute to the continuation of his work."
