OUR WAY OF LIFE. We should be honest! Most of us have prejudices when things we are used to change or when we meet others who behave in an utterly different way, or have a set of beliefs that is very different to those we are used to in our culture. There are prejudices against groups of people, or prejudices against new situations. The good news of Jesus asks us to go beyond all those things and remain in God alone.

A REFLECTION. At the heart of the mass, the consecration of the bread and wine, we are invited sometimes to make this response: "Save us, Saviour of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection, you have set us free". God wants us to have the freedom of the children of God, to be at home everywhere, to go beyond prejudices.

WORD OF LIFE

"You received without payment; give without payment". (Mt 10:8)

'Throughout the Gospel, Jesus invites his disciples to give: to "give to the poor" (Mk 10:21). "Give to the one who asks of you and...to one who wants to borrow" (Mt 5:42). "If anyone wants... your tunic, hand them your cloak as well" (Mt 5:40); to give without payment. Jesus was the first to give, restoring health to the sick, forgiving sinners and giving his life for us all.

To counteract our instinct to hoard, Jesus calls for generosity; to overcome our inclination to worry about our own needs. He shifts the focus to our neighbours, and in place of the culture of having, he puts the culture of giving.
