Daring to Care We have been praying for our Synod 2020 that is now very close that by God's grace as we journey towards the Synod God will help us to become the Church that God is calling us to be. Pope Francis wants the Church as a whole to be a "synodal" Church. This means a Church in which all the members walk together supporting each other. It is the way that we are trying also to work towards in our parish, a small cell of the Church. We need to dare to walk together to care for the present and the future of the Church.

This way of "being Church" relates directly to the meaning of the Holy Trinity, our feast day today. We need a feast to celebrate something that is the life of the members of the Church. But also, the Holy Trinity is the One God that we believe in.

Some people find the Holy Trinity does not relate to their life at all and remains a rather strange and forbidding mystery. But it is so straight-forward. For example, whenever there is One living Group of people all gathered for a single purpose it reflects the Trinity. Take Sunday mass: One Mass, but many different people involved. Many but One. In a conversation of goodwill between two people there are two people and between them "good will" which is very close to Love. There is the relationship of friendship that is a reality but invisible. Two persons in God and perfect Love in God: the Love is personified, Three in One, Trinity.

Dare to care not to see other people and all around us as an obstacle for us to exploit selfishly, but as part of a single whole. One and manifold. Life is Trinitarian.

Word of Life God is love, and those who abide in love abide in God, and God abides in them. (1 Jn 4:16)

Focolare founder, Chiara Lubich, offers us a valuable suggestion to help us live this word of the Gospel "*We can no longer separate the cross from glory, we cannot separate the Crucified Lord from the Risen One. They are two aspects of the same mystery of God who is Love. ... Let us try to fulfil what God wants from us, wherever we are: ... let us try to love the people around us. If we do this, the effect will be surprising and more than we could hope for: our soul will be filled with peace, love and even pure joy and light.... And, enriched by this experience, we will be able to help all our brothers and sisters more effectively to find happiness amidst their tears and to transform all that is troubling them into serenity. In this way we will become instruments of joy for many people, instruments of that happiness for which every human heart yearns.*"
