Daring to Care The UK will host the 26th UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties (COP 26) in Glasgow on 31 October – 12 November 2021. The COP 26 summit will bring parties together to accelerate action towards the goals of the Paris Agreement and the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change. The UK is committed to working with all countries and joining forces with civil society, companies and people on the frontline of climate change to inspire climate action ahead of COP 26.

What can we in the parish do? If anybody is interested in seeing how we as a parish can get involved please contact Fr Jonathan on the website or by directly emailing him on jonathancotton43@gmail.com. There is some interesting material available that a small group could study to see what we can do in practice and then invite us to enter a parish project for those who wish. One of the most important things is to invite people to have what is called "An Ecological Conversion". We need to be aware that we must change in order to make take care of our common home. The encyclical of Pope Francis is very helpful here. It is clear that this is something that will happen if we do not act individually but with the help of others. It could be an ecumenical project to propose to Churches Together in Leyland; that proposal would come better from a group of St Mary's parishioners.

Word of Life Take heart daughter; your faith has made you well. This certainty also allows us to bring salvation by tenderly 'touching' those who are suffering, in need, darkness or feeling lost. This is what happened to a mother from Venezuela who found the courage to forgive: 'I was feeling desperate for help when I attended a meeting on the Gospel where I heard Jesus' words: "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God", and "Love your enemies." Love your enemies. How could I forgive those who had killed my son? But in the meantime, a seed had entered into me and the decision to forgive finally prevailed. Now I can truly call myself a "child of God". Recently I was called to a meeting with my son's killer who had been caught. It was hard but grace intervened. There was no hatred or rancour in my heart, only great pity, and the intention to entrust him to God's mercy.'
