**Our first understanding of the New Covid Guidelines for St Mary's Leyland.**

Considering public health advice, the need to encourage vaccinations (and boosters) and the call in-charity to safeguard one another, the following is the latest guidance for the Archdiocese.

**Holy Water** From now on until further instructions we will have Holy Water in the stoups.

**Face coverings** are strongly recommended for all who enter church for all services. Continue to wear them.

**Sanitizing hands**, We will continue offering the possibility to sanitise hands before and after entry to church.

**Celebrating Mass and other liturgies** We will return to the normal mode of celebrating mass and other liturgies. Holy communion will remain under one kind only (the Sacred Host.). There will be no Holy Communion on the tongue.

**Social distancing** The section of seats on the left as you enter Church will remain for those who want both social distancing and to receive Holy Communion in the bench. The national guidelines say there is no need for social distancing to continue. Our response is to agree it is a sensitive and positive thing to have an official space where parishioners would prefer to be.

**Good ventilation** will continue in Church

**Ministers of the Eucharist** will continue to sanitise before and after administering the Sacrament.

**Visits** to the housebound and sick can happen bearing in mind the need to ensure that infection is not spread.

**Dare to Care** We need to dare to care about the Synodal process; that is that all in the people of God need to help each other walking together to promote the life of the Church for the sake of unity for the world.

***Pope Francis put it this way aware of the realities when change is about to happen: at the opening of the Synod of Bishops on Young People 3 October 2018***

'Let us work to "spend time with the future", to take from this Synod not merely a document – that generally is only read by a few and criticized by many – but above all concrete pastoral proposals capable of fulfilling the Synod's purpose. In other words, to plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a dawn of hope, learn from one another, and create a bright resourcefulness that will enlighten minds, warm hearts, and give strength to our hands.'

**Our Liverpool Pastoral Plan** based on our Synod with 4 issues that are then amplified in the document:

- 1 *Be immersed in the joys and hopes, griefs and anxieties of humanity today.*
- 2 *Be brave and creative in renewing local structures*
- 3 *Develop leadership to attend to changing needs*
- 4 *Embed synodality in every aspect of archdiocesan life.*

This affirmation made by Jesus is part of a dialogue with the crowd that was surrounding him.
