DARE TO CARE

Daring to Care begins in God. Jesus on the cross cared so much he broke his heart for us in that cry "My God, my God, why have you deserted me" The feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (last Friday) is the feast of the greatness of his humanity; and now, risen in his body, his heart still beats in heaven for us.

The parish through the St Vincent de Paul group is currently supporting a family of asylum seekers from El Salvador. There will be requests detailing how parishioners can help them in the bulletin, in the coming weeks. Churches Together in Leyland and other churches support other asylum seekers housed at the Leyland Hotel. Updates, and requests for help will be in the bulletin.

Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion Celine Godinho organises the Ministers for distribution of Holy Communion at the two Sunday Masses, and Sister Veronica looks after the Ministers for Holy Communion to the sick and housebound. Our food system is broken, it does not work for the people who work the hardest and it does not work for the planet. Profit comes before people and the farmers who grow our food live in poverty. The Word of Life You are my Lord; I have no good apart from you. (Ps 16[15]:2)

So how can we live the Word of Life this month? Here is CD's experience: "Some time ago I began to feel unwell, so I underwent a series of medical examinations which needed a great deal of waiting. Finally, I found out what was wrong with me: I had Parkinson's disease... it was a huge blow! I was 58 years old: how could I have Parkinson's? I asked myself why it was happening to me. I taught Motor and Sport Sciences and so physical activity was part of me! I was losing something too important. But then I thought back to the choice I had made when I was young: "You, Jesus crucified and forsaken, are my only good!" Thanks to the medication I started to feel much better at once, but I do not know exactly what will happen to me in the future. I decided to live in the present moment. After the diagnosis, quite spontaneously, I wrote a song: I wanted to sing to God saying "Yes, my soul is filled with peace!"

The words of this psalm also resonated deeply in the soul of Focolare founder, Chiara Lubich. She wrote: "*These simple words will help us to trust in him and will train us to live with Love. Always more united to God and filled with him, we will continually lay down the foundations of our true selves as beings made in his image.*"

During June, we can unite with others all over the world in raising a "declaration of love" to God and radiate peace and serenity around us.
