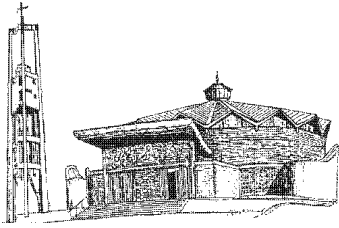

PREPARATION FOR THE POPE'S VISIT

- The Pope comes in just over three weeks. See the hand out from the Press office in the Vatican to give some indication of what it will be like.
- **Public Pilgrimage in honour of the Blessed Dominic Barberi** on Thursday 26th August (his feast day) with Mass at 6.30 pm at the Church of St Anne and Blessed Dominic, St Helens. Chief Celebrant and guest speaker: Archbishop Patrick Kelly. Blessed Dominic received Cardinal Newman into full communion with the Church on 8th October 1845, and Pope Benedict has referred to him often in the preparation for his coming to England and beatifying Cardinal Newman. This is an Archdiocesan preparation for the Pope's visit and would be ideal for any who are not going to see him in London or Birmingham. Bus departs 5pm: sign the list if you wish to come.
- **Daily recitation of the Bishops' prayer** for the forthcoming visit of the Pope. See at the end of the bulletin or take a copy from the back of the Church
