WORD OF LIFE

'You shall love your neighbour as yourself' (Mk 12:31)

Here is one of those words of the Gospel that demands to be put into action immediately, this very instant. It is so utterly clear, and demanding, that it does not need a huge amount of comment. Jesus is not the only one to take up the teaching about the central place of love, but he put together, as a single commandment, the love of God and the love of neighbour. The reply he gives to the scribe who is questioning him is in fact 'the first is, Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one; you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength. The second is this, "You shall love your neighbour as yourself" There is no other commandment greater than these.
