### Preparing for the Archdiocesan Assembly "The Lord's Day"

November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012. According to the gospels the resurrection of Jesus from the dead took place on the first day after the Sabbath.... on this same day the Lord appeared to the two disciples of Emmaus... and to the eleven in the Upper Room. (Dies Domini 20)

*We celebrate Sunday because it is the day Christ rose from the dead. We gather and break bread so as to make Christ's presence real again. No Sunday is complete without sharing in the Mass, without being present with neighbours, family, friends and even strangers gathered round the altar together.*

#### **For reflection:**

- What keeps you and your household from participating in Sunday Mass? Can you overcome these obstacles? You are invited to think together or individually and let us have your responses in written form.

### WORD OF LIFE

**Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty. The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water gushing up to eternal life (Jn 4:13-14)**

There is another secret that Jesus has revealed to us, a kind of bottomless well we can draw from. When two or three are united in his name, loving each other with his very own love, he is in their midst (Mt 18:20). And it is then that we feel free, one, full of light and torrents of living water flow within us (Jn 7:38). It is Jesus' promise that comes true because it is from Jesus himself, present among us, that thirst-quenching water gushes up for eternity.
