October is the month of the Holy Rosary. The Power of the Rosary should never be underestimated. Pope John Paul 2 was a philosopher, a thinker and a poet. His intellectual gifts did not prevent him from being a child of the gospel and praying the rosary to resolve the problems he felt were important. He contributed to the fall of the great Communist Empire in Europe in 1989 - 1990. Another great English Saint, Thomas More, perhaps the greatest Englishman of all called himself "God's Beadsman" because he said the rosary. He too was a part of the intellectual elite of his age. At Fatima in 1917 Our Lady told the three poor peasant children: "Recite the rosary every day to obtain the peace for the world and the end of the war. I am the Lady of the Rosary" This month is the month of the Rosary and it would be good to say it at home, in Church after mass and pray for all the graces we need in our days. On October 7th 1571, a Christian fleet that was not as strong as the Ottoman fleet managed to win the victory at Lepanto. It was attributed to the power of the rosary. Any need you have will be relieved by this prayer.

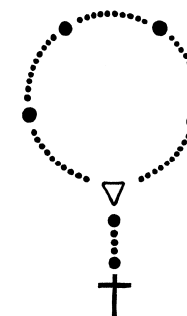
