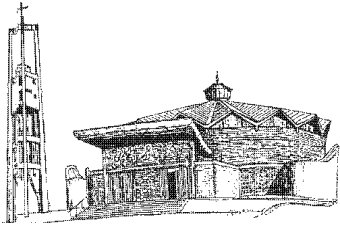

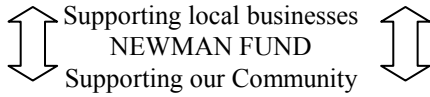

WORD OF LIFE

Follow me (Matthew 9:9)

Going against every social convention, Jesus called Matthew to follow him and accepted the invitation to dine at his home. Later he would do the same with Zaccheus, the chief tax collector in Jericho. When questioned about his behaviour, Jesus answered that he had come to heal the sick, not the healthy, and to call not the righteous, but sinners. When he called Matthew he called one of these. Jesus had already spoken those words to Andrew, Peter, James and John on the shore of the lake. He gave the same invitation, in different words, to Paul on the road to Damascus. But Jesus did not stop there. Throughout the centuries he has continued to call men and women of every people and nation. He still does so today: he comes into our lives and meets us in different places and different ways, and once more we hear his invitation "Follow me."
