**WORD OF LIFE**

*Christ, the Church's one foundation (cf 1 Cor 3:11)*

Faced with the divisions that rocked the community, Paul vigorously intervened. He emphasized that the Church, like a building, like a temple, may have many builders. But it has a sole foundation, the living stone: Jesus Christ. In this month in particular, during the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, Christian Churches and communities remember together that Christ is their one foundation and that it is only by following him and living his one Gospel that they will reach full and visible unity among themselves. To base our lives on Christ means to be one with him, to think as he thinks, to want as he wants, to live as he lived. But how can we be grounded, rooted in him? How can we be perfectly one with him?

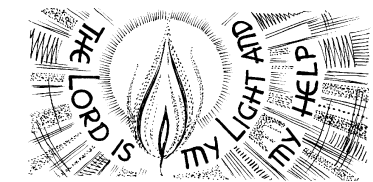
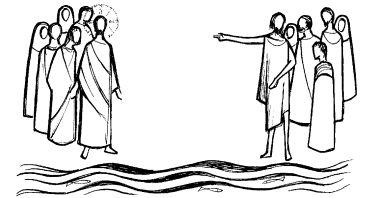
