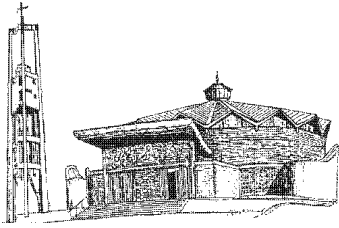

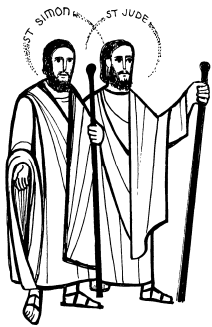
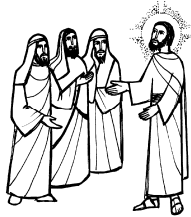

Today is World Mission Sunday - this is our chance to be united with Catholics all over the world in prayer, friendship and support. Through Missio, Catholics are able to actively share in the mission of Jesus: proclaiming the boundless love of God to all peoples. The money collected today will go in its entirety to support mission projects worldwide. - On Sunday 6th November we will have the annual mass at 11am for all who have died in the past year. The list of names that we have already is up on the board and you can see if your family member or friend is included. If you wish to add somebody dear to you who has died in the past year, **then you must let Lesley know by Monday 31st October.** He or she should have died in the past 12 months. At this mass a family member or friend brings a candle representing those whose name is remembered at the offertory of the mass.
- Monday 21st November at 7pm for about 45 minutes our annual service with slides of those who have died; you may light candles if you wish to do so, and prayers and hymns with the One Voice Choir. Those whose photos we have are on the list that is in the Narthex. If you wish to add anyone, we will need the photo and the date of death, by Thursday 10th November and hand in to the Priory for us to scan or email the photo to administratorstmarysleyland@btconnect.com. We will produce a slide for the service. You will have your photo back again.
