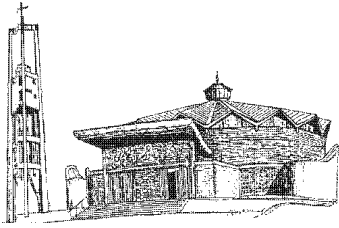

WORD OF LIFE

If you say so, I will let down the nets (Lk 5:5)

How can we put this Word of Life into practice? By making the same choice as Peter: 'If you say so . . .' By having faith in his Word; by not questioning what he asks. On the contrary: basing our behaviour, our way of acting, our life on his Word. By doing this we will base our existence on something solid and secure, and to our amazement we'll see that, precisely where all human resources are lacking, he intervenes, and that where humanly it is impossible, life is born.

Preparing for the Archdiocesan Assembly "The Lord's day"

November 24th 2012

It is important that Sunday Mass be prepared with special care. Efforts must be made to ensure that the celebration has the festive character appropriate to the day commemorating the Lord's Resurrection. (DD 50)

In our celebration of Mass on a Sunday we are led to communion with each other and the Lord. It is a solemn moment and one of great joy. We are all called to take an active part in what goes on at Sunday Mass and each of us, lay and ordained, has a specific role to play.

For reflection: Can I participate in a different way in the celebration of Mass - by exercising a ministry or by a different way of praying the liturgy?
