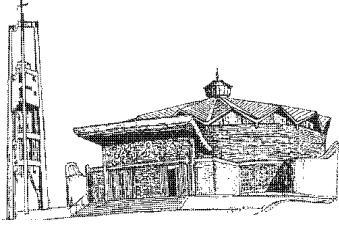

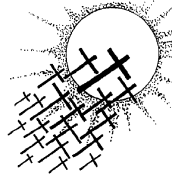

Pilgrimage to Holy Land In the footsteps of Jesus: Thursday 15th March - Thursday 22nd March 2012. Fr. Jonathan is going on this pilgrimage: it is ecumenical, and is in the footsteps of Jesus, not a visit to Israel, and in full solidarity with the Palestinian Christians who are going through a very difficult time. Some possible pilgrims have been worried about the political situation and the organiser in Jerusalem, a French lady has written:

About the pilgrimage, we also feel the difficulty to reach a number of people. This year we had some cancellation of groups and also problems to have enough pilgrims, so numbers in the groups are less. I can understand that all of this is the result of the political situation in countries around Israel. But I can assure you that the situation here in the Holy Land is quiet as usual and you can have a safe and peaceful tour in all the holy places.

Total cost for the week including the coaches and guides and accommodation and flights is c. £907 for a double room or £1057 for a single room. Costs will depend on the numbers coming (we need 50 and have not reached that figure). Interested? See Fr. Jonathan.
