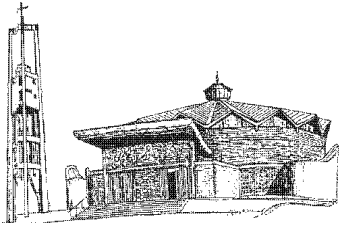

WORD OF LIFE

Those who love me will keep my word, and my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them (John 14:23) Jesus is giving his great and heartfelt farewell discourses to his apostles. He assures them, among other things, that they will see him again, because he will reveal himself to those who love him..... Jesus states clearly how he will continue to be present in the midst of his own after his death, and he explains how it will be possible to have contact with him. He can be present in Christians and in the midst of the community right now. There is no need to wait for the future. The temple that welcomes him is not so much one of bricks and mortar, but the very heart of the Christian, which becomes the new tabernacle, the living dwelling place of the Trinity. *Copies of the full text are on the table in front of the Piety Shop or on the website.
