WAY OF LIFE Pope Francis says, "Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten journey of forty days, leading us to the Easter Triduum, the memorial of the Lord's passion, death and resurrection, and the heart of the mystery of our salvation. Lent prepares us for this most important moment; therefore it is a "powerful" season, a turning point that can foster change and conversion.

We all need to improve, to change for the better. Lent helps us and thus we leave behind old habits and the lazy addiction to the evil that deceives and ensnares us.

Reflection: What are you doing for Lent this year? How will it help you leave behind your old habits and lazy addictions? How will you become more merciful? WORD OF LIFE 'The Kingdom of God has come to you. (Lk 11.20) In the Gospel passage that this Word of life comes from, Jesus had just healed a man who was mute, freeing him from the devil who held him prisoner. It was the demonstration that he had come to conquer evil, every evil, and finally establish the kingdom of God. this term the 'kingdom of God' was the Jewish people's way of saying the God acted for the sake of Israel, freeing the people from every form of slavery and evil, guiding them to justice and peace, flooding them with joy and good things. This was the act of that God who Jesus revealed as 'Father' - mysterious, loving and full or compassion, aware of the needs and sufferings of each of his children.
