Music at Mass The new words for the Liturgy guide the choices for any given Mass including music and the task of the Choir and Folk Group is to give worthy praise and glory to God and encourage all to sing so the whole congregation is involved together on earth as it is in heaven. The mass is meant to be a foretaste of heaven. In discussion with Fr. Jonathan these are the arrangements. At the 9.30am Mass the folk group have decided to use on occasions the older tunes so that all can easily join in until new tunes fitting new words are learnt. At 11am the choir choose music that the congregation can 'pick up' and join in.
