Through their countless martyrs they were about to give witness to the sincerity and depth of their devotion to the Gospel, but among them, just as elsewhere, there was no lack of tensions, misunderstandings and even rivalries. In fact, the Christians in Rome came from a variety of social, cultural and religious backgrounds. There were some who came from Judaism and others from the Hellenic world and the ancient religion of Rome, perhaps from Stoicism or from other oriental philosophies.

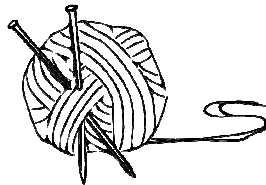

St Mary's Catholic High School. In response to some questions that have arisen and after discussion with the Parish Pastoral Council last Wednesday Fr. Jonathan issues this statement. "On 12th December 2014 Ampleforth Abbey Trustees resolved to hand over the Trusteeship of our St. Mary's Leyland Catholic High School to the Trusteeship of the Archdiocese. This was because Ampleforth Trustees did not have the capacity to support the school out of the special measures that were required after the latest Ofsted Report. The pastoral care of the school continues under the care of the monks from Ampleforth who look after the parish. There is no change in the day to day close contact for spiritual affairs of the school. Through the monks and with willing support from Ampleforth and the school leadership, the links with Ampleforth will be maintained.

Celebrating the Year of Consecrated Life in the Archdiocese Saturday 7th February there is the "**Living Joyfully**" event in our Catholic Cathedral for which you will see posters. It promises to be what it says: a joy filled time as Religious and Consecrated people are together to show the beauty of the life they lead. All are most welcome to come and it would be a pity to miss something that will be authentic and counter cultural, helping to lift the blues of many people who have no knowledge of the warmth, light and happiness of a close relationship with God. It is not just a time to promote vocations, but much more. The organised programme begins at 10.30am, with a chance to visit displays set up in the Cathedral. From 1pm to 6pm workshops, there are discussion groups, a chance to meet priests, religious and consecrated laity and share with them. We hope to have some of the Leyland monks present and Sister Veronica (though we will be back for the Parish dinner). For those who can stay Mass with Archbishop Malcolm will be at 6.30pm.
