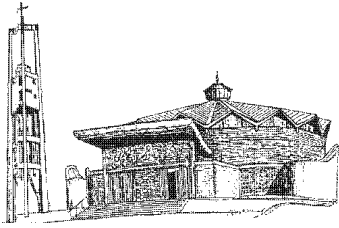

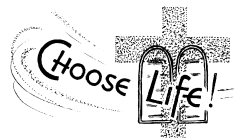
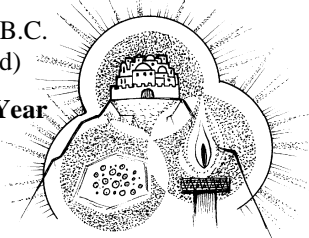

WORD OF LIFE

All who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God (Rom. 8:14)
This Word of Life comes at the heart of Paul's hymn to the beauty of Christian life, to its newness and freedom, the fruit of baptism and faith in Jesus. These graft us fully into him, and through him, into the dynamism of the life of the Trinity. By becoming one person with Christ, we share in his Spirit and in all the fruits of the Spirit. First and foremost we become children of God. Even though Paul speaks of 'adoption' (see Rom. 8:15; Gal. 4:5), he does so simply to distinguish it from being a 'natural child' which is true only of the one Son of God.

CHANGES IN THE WAY WE CELEBRATE THE SACRAMENTS.

Parishioners will have seen the A5 letter about the changes that will happen in the Archdiocese for the celebration of the Sacraments.

At the heart of this new initiative is the emphasis that will be placed on the families of the children who will enter the journey of initiation into the fullness of life in the Church through Reconciliation, Confirmation and Eucharist.

It makes a big difference to our faith when we belong to a family where the things of God and the joys of being united with Christ and each other are important in the home. The influence lasts for all our lives and will contribute to our own self-esteem, to the making sense of all that will come our way in life, and ultimately to our growth into the person that we are meant to be. Our final destiny is to be one with God for ever.

The role of catechists in the future will be to assist parents in their joyful task of being the first and best teachers in the ways of faith.
