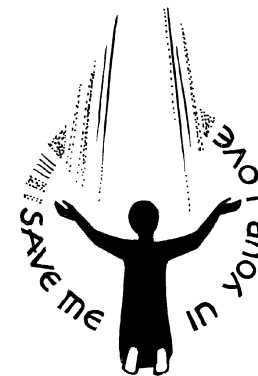

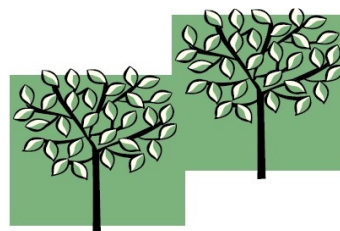


**Year of Consecrated Life.** The Pope has called Consecrated People in this year of Consecrated Life "to wake up the world". This does not mean Consecrated People have to be more loyal to Jesus, because that is not specific for the Consecrated. It is for all the People of God. "Wake up the World" is for the Consecrated to

be prophets specifically through the evangelical counsels (i.e. the vows) of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience within the specific charism of each group. Take Chastity; not fashionable today. How can you live without physical intimacy? Yet in Fr. Martin (as with Fr. Theo, his direct contemporary) we see full human beings who have lived out this vow and the other two vows also to the best of their ability. It is quite possible today to grow fully as a human being and to live the equivalent of poverty, chastity and obedience. In Fr. Martin we see a consecrated man who is very human and has now gained his eternal reward in heaven. Do not be negative about the consecrated life or that of diocesan priesthood in your own families. Pray for Fr. Martin, pray for all in Consecrated Life and pray for the monks of our Abbey at Ampleforth. Fr. Martin will pray for you.
