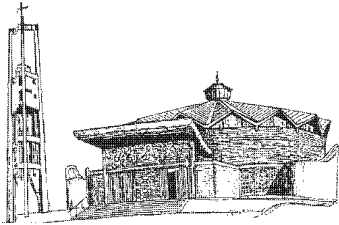


# Regenerating the Parish

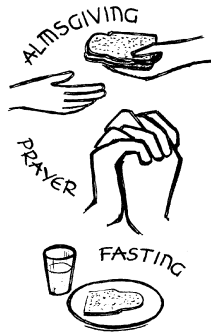

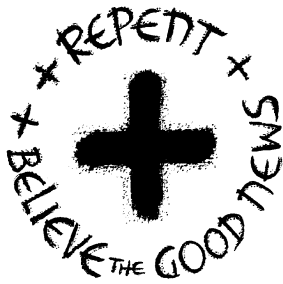

#### WORD OF LIFE

**I am the gate. Whoever enters by me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture (Jn 10:9)**  
In his forsakenness on the cross, Jesus became our access to the father. His part has been done. But to have the good that comes from so much grace, we must, each one, do our small part, which means to go up to that gate and pass through it. How? When we are taken aback by disappointment, damaged by trauma or a misfortune coming out of the blue or an illness that makes no sense, we can always remember the suffering of Jesus.
