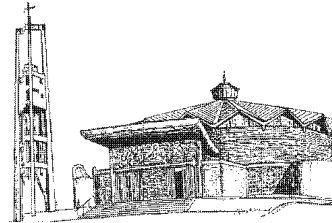

b) We also are hoping to complete phase 2 of our heating project that should enable us to have low cost and effective heating in our Church that is so difficult to heat, for the foreseeable future. Plans are still to be finalised including of course costs. There will be fund raising in different ways using some of the events for fund-raising and trusting in God's providence. He has always looked after us and we can live the Jubilee to the full, trusting always in him and his love for us.
