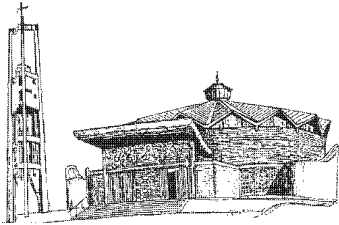

- Indifference?
- A dreary time?
- Or ????

While forty days may seem like a long time, especially on Ash

Wednesday, living the experience with a sense of joy and with the spiritual longing for Holy Easter which St. Benedict instructs us to do will help us to experience the Holy Season of Easter with even greater joy than we might otherwise have had if we did not go through the penances of Lent.

We could:

- find out about prayer and the scriptures.
- celebrate mass and receive Holy Communion more
- deepen our relationship with God, with His help.
- take on some small sacrificial practices,
- fast as our forebears did so regularly on Wednesdays and Fridays.
- review their lives and put right things that have gone wrong. Sacrament of Reconciliation?

We all need quiet and peace to let God in to our lives, and to grow in relationship with God. "Do now what will profit you forever.
