WAY OF LIFE

In the Baptism ceremony the child to be baptised is called "chosen by God". "This is my child, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." God is calling us, his disciples, to do great things in little ways.

REFLECTION The God of peace will be with us if we follow Jesus, know him more and more and do the things he teaches us.

WORD OF LIFE '*Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus.*' (Phil. 2:5)

What is this 'mind'? How can we know the deepest desires Jesus had, so as to imitate him?

Paul understood how: Jesus Christ, the Son of God, had emptied himself and had come down among us. He became man and was completely at the service of the Father, so that we could become children of God. (Paul had written about this to the Galatians, saying, 'And because you are children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"' (Gal 4:6). And in John's Gospel it says, 'But to all who received him, who believed in his name, he gave power to become children of God' (Jn 1:12).)

Jesus had fulfilled his mission through the way he lived his whole life. He continually humbled himself so as to reach those who were the most small, weak or insecure: lepers, widows, strangers or sinners. He raised them up, making them feel loved and saved at last.
