OUR WAY OF LIFE Eucharist is... a challenge to become what we receive. In receiving Holy Communion at Mass and in saying "Amen" to the declaration that this is the Body of Christ, we accept the challenge Saint Augustine spoke about: to become what we receive. We walk as a body of people with Christ at its head and centre, showing us the way. We walk as a body of people in which each plays a part. We walk together as one body in which each part is needed and each valued.

A REFLECTION Pope Francis quotes St Benedict in his letter about holiness in the modern world. Can we not realize what Jesus demands of us? He tells us that in welcoming the stranger we welcome him (cf. Mt 25:35)? Saint Benedict did so readily, and though it might have "complicated" the life of his monks, he ordered that all guests who knocked at the monastery door be welcomed "like Christ", with a gesture of veneration; the poor and pilgrims were to be met with "the greatest care and solicitude". (Paragraph 102)

WORD OF LIFE My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness (2 Cor 12: 9) Chiara Lubich wrote: Jesus was strongest just at his weakest moment. He could have given life to the new people of God just by preaching or doing a few more miracles or some extraordinary deed. Instead it was not so because the Church is the work of God and it is in suffering, and only in suffering, that the works of God flourish. So our weakness and the awareness of our fragility present unique opportunities to experience the strength of Christ who died and is risen.'

It is the paradox of the gospel: the meek are promised they will inherit the earth.
