Living in love is not simply the fruit of our own efforts. The spirit who has been given to us gives us the strength to grow in freedom from the slavery of selfishness and to live in love. And we continually ask for the Holy Spirit. Chiara Lubich wrote *'Love is what moves us, it suggests how to respond to situations and to the choices we are called to make. Love teaches us how to discern: this is good and I'll do it: this is bad and I won't do it. Love is what urges us to act in a way that is best for others. We are not guided by an external force but by the principle of new life that the Spirit has placed within us. Our heart, mind and strength, and all our abilities, can walk according to the Spirit because they are united by love and completely open to God's plan for us and for society. We are free to love.'*
